## 1. Composition of teams and conditions of entry.

- 1.1. Where a country is represented by only one team, its delegation may comprise 16 persons. A full delegation (2 teams) will comprise 31 persons. 2 additional persons are allowed.
- 1.2. Each country which enters teams must provide one referee per team. All referees shall be in possession of a national (highest level) or international qualification. Their status is to be certified, on accreditation, by a document or licence authenticated by the national Volleyball federation and valid for the current year.
- 1.3. Before the start of the Competition each delegation shall present to the Control Commission:
  - payment of the balance owing or proof that this has been paid
  - for each participant, a passport or official identity card bearing photo, surname, forename, date of birth and nationality
  - the original document certifying that each student of the school team is normally registered at that school from the beginning of the school year
  - list of players with their shirt number.

## 2. Dates

- 2.1. Delegations are to arrive on Saturday 25 June 2016.
- 2.2. Delegations are to depart after breakfast on Sunday 3 July 2016.
- 2.3. The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the OC (exception see item 2.4).
- 2.4. When the distance between Belgrade and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000 kilometres the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier **or** leaving one day later at the normal daily fee (50 EUR).
- 2.5. The organiser will be able to give you information on alternative accommodation in the area for your use outside the period of the World Schools Championship and for those accompanying the delegation.

## 3. Board, lodging and services

- 3.1. All students, coaches, Heads of Delegation and referees will be accommodated in following hotels in Belgrade:

- 3.2. Students will be accommodated in rooms with 2 – 3 bedded rooms.  
The Heads of Delegation will be accommodated in single rooms in the same hotel as the players.  
Team managers (coaches/teachers) and referees will be accommodated in twin bedded rooms.  
The ISF delegate and the members of the ISF Technical Commission for Volleyball will be accommodated in single rooms in Hotel Srbija Garni\*\*\*\* <http://hotelsrbijagarni.com/en/>
- 3.3. Meals will be taken at the hotels  
Arrival day : lunch and/or dinner (according to arrival time)  
Other days : breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served at the hotels.  
Departure day : breakfast – lunch or packed meal (according to departure time and to meals on arrival day).
- 3.4. A medical service will be available throughout the duration of the Championship.
- 3.5. A laundry service is available at the hotels at the participants cost.
- 3.6. Free WIFI will be available in the hotels.

#### 4. General rules

These rules will apply to all teams and participants and will remain fixed for the duration of this World Schools Championship.

- 4.1. The Organising Committee will be responsible for the running and control of the World Schools Championship.
- 4.2. The World Schools Championship is organised according to International School Sport Federation competition rules.
- 4.3. The Organising Committee will nominate a Control Commission, a Disciplinary Commission and an Appeal Jury. Their responsibilities will be specified in Bulletin 3.

#### 5. Technical rules and plan of play

- 5.1. All matches will be played in accordance with International School Sport Federation competition rules, the Official FIVB Volleyball Rules, the Specific ISF Volleyball regulations based on the FIVB U19-U20 and FIVB Sports Regulations.
- 5.2. Mixed teams are forbidden.
- 5.3. Net height: boys = 2.43m and girls = 2.24m



5.4. The number of sets to win a match and the plan of play after the preliminary round will be specified in bulletin 3.

5.5. A classification will be set up from the first to the last team.

5.6. The official competition ball to be used will be announced in bulletin 3.

## 6. Deposit

6.1. If you have not yet paid the deposit, be informed that the deadline is November 30<sup>th</sup>. The deposit (100 EUR per person) must be sent as a single payment for the whole delegation by the Organisation responsible for School Sport. Payments made by individual schools will not be accepted.

The sum of the deposit will be deducted from the total cost of participation. The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation, unless the registered country has informed the organisers before the draw or in the case of unusual or unforeseen circumstances. The latter instance will require the approval of the ISF Management Committee.

## 7. Group draw

7.1. The group draw will take place in Belgrade on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2016 during an Organising Committee meeting in the presence of the ISF delegate and the President of ISF Volleyball Technical Commission.

7.2. The draw will be made in public.

7.3. The draw will take into account results achieved in the 3 last ISF Volleyball Championships.

7.4. If after the draw one or more teams withdraw from the competition the ISF Technical Commission Volleyball may modify the draw in order to balance the number of teams in each group.

7.5. The Organising Committee will publish the draw on the ISF Internet site and thereafter, as required, all alterations.

- c. name of Head of Delegation
- d. names of accompanying adults (teachers/coaches)

- g. names of boys and girls school teams' schools
- h. names of additional persons
- i. precise information on travel times
- j. particular dietary requirements
- k. special requests
- l. passport photos
- m. e-mails of all registered persons
