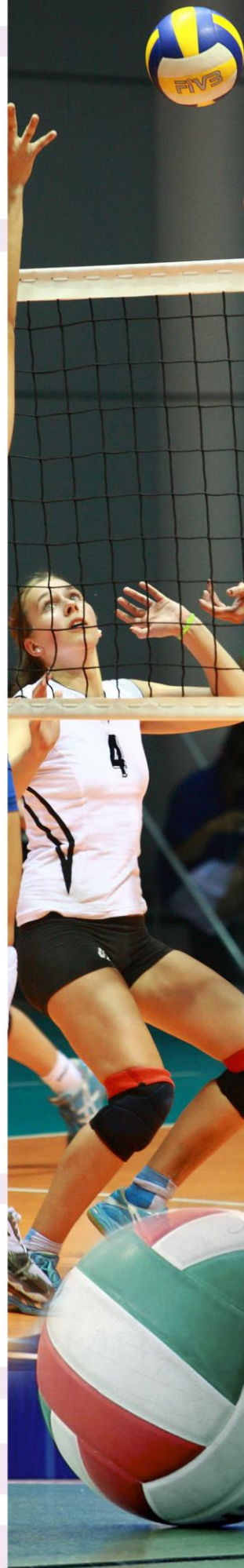

We have pleasure in sending you Bulletin 3 for the **World Schools Championship - ISF Volleyball 2016** which will take place from Saturday 25th June till Sunday 3rd July 2016 in Belgrade, Serbia.

The championship is organised by the Serbia School Sport Federation according to International School Sport Federation competition rules.

This bulletin contains further information to that published in Bulletin 1 and 2.

1. RESULT OF THE DRAW

The draw of the groups took place on 5th February 2016. Many personalities from the sport and political world, among others Predrag Peruničić, Secretary of State for Sport, Aleksandar Boričić, President of CEV and Vice-President of the World Volleyball Federation FIVB, joined the event at the Serbia Palace in Belgrade. Zeljko Tanaskovic, President of the Serbian School Sport Federation hosted the event in the presence of the ISF representatives TC president Volleyball Monique Krecké-Giver and Jan Coolen, ISF Secretary General/ISF delegate.

2. INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP EVENING

Delegations are required to take part in an “International Friendship Evening” organised with the aim of encouraging exchanges between the different cultures of participating countries. The young people are invited to introduce and to promote their countries and their culture in an original way. Each delegation is to organise a stand at the “Tourist Fair” on the theme ‘Suppose you came to spend your holidays in my country’. This presentation may be made in the form of leaflets, video, CD, photos or other original ideas, for example by offering a taste of typical culinary specialities (dishes, drinks, ...). In addition each delegation may, if it wishes, introduce a facet of its country’s culture on stage (the stage is yours – dance, songs, sketches ...) maximum 4 minutes.

4. FINANCES AND INSURANCE

- 4.1. In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the World Schools Championship amount to 50 EUR per person and per night for a maximum of 16 persons (with one team entered) or 31 persons (with 2 teams entered). 2 additional persons are allowed.
- 4.2. An additional ISF levy of 40 EUR per delegation member will be collected at the time of registration.
- 4.3. The total sum per person is therefore 400 EUR + 40 EUR = 440 EUR (minus the deposit).
For the additional persons, see bulletin 1 - paragraph 5.6.
- 4.4. The balance of the sum due can be paid in EUR into the organisers' bank account at the latest by 1st June 2016.

All bank charges are the responsibility of the delegations!

The balance of the sum shall be paid in cash in EUR by the Head of Delegation on arrival. Payment by bank cards and /or credit cards will not be accepted.

5. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- 5.1. All matches will be played according to International Volleyball Federation (FIVB) rules and the ISF regulations. See document attached.

- 5.2. Net height: Boys: 2,43m / Girls: 2,24m
- 5.3. Only the 12 players, registered on the team's list handed in at the accreditation, are authorised to play from the beginning to the end of the competitions. Each player will wear the same shirt number given at the accreditation during the entire championship.
- 5.4. System of play
 - 1st Round – Qualification Matches – 8 groups of maximum 4 teams (all x all).
 - 2nd Round – Classification Matches – overcrossing the groups
 - 3rd Round – Classification Matches

5th Round – Final Ranking Matches

- 5.5. The official competition ball will be MIKASA MVA 200.
- 5.6. Training and warm-up ball will be MIKASA MVA 330.
The OC will make 6 balls available to each team for training and warm-up.
- 5.7. All matches will be played best of 3 sets. The semi-final matches as well as the finals and the matches for the 3rd and 4th place, will be played best of 5 sets.
- 5.8. The competition will be held on 16 courts in 11 sports halls, all situated in the city of Belgrade except for 1 hall in Pancevo, about 40 minutes out of Belgrade.

6. CONTROL COMMISSION

- 6.1. In accordance with General Competition Rules the Organising Committee will designate a Control Commission composed of:
 - representatives of the ISF Technical Commission Volleyball
 - 1 representative of the OC
- 6.2. At accreditation, the Head of Delegation must settle with the organisers the balance to be paid including any bank charges and will present the following documents to the Control Commission:
 - proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges,
 - the passport of every student bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth,
 - a letter from the headmaster of the school confirming that all students of the school teams are full time students at his/her school, since the beginning of the school year.
- 6.3. When checking is complete, each participant will receive an accreditation card which allows him/her access to the competition, activities and meals.

7. DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION

- 7.1. In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the Disciplinary Commission will be composed of:
 - the Delegate representing the ISF Executive Committee
 - the President of the ISF Technical Commission of Volleyball
 - the President of the Organising Committee

The Disciplinary Commission will deal with all matters relating to discipline arising during the championship matches and also during the period of the Championship where the matters are not covered by technical regulations.

- 7.2. The Disciplinary Commission's decisions are final. They are passed on to the Executive Committee.



- 7.3. It should be noted that where there is a sufficiently serious lack of respect for ISF rules the Disciplinary Commission could disqualify participants, teams or delegations from the competition and to require them to return home before the end of the event.

8. APPEAL JURY

- 8.1. In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the Appeal Jury will be composed of:
- a representative of the ISF Technical Commission of Volleyball
 - a representative of the Organising Committee
 - a representative of the Referees
- 8.2. The Appeal Jury will decide on all appeals concerning the results of the competition in the light of the rules of FIVB and the rules of the ISF Technical Commission of Volleyball.
- 8.3. The Appeal Jury will not pronounce on disciplinary matters.
- 8.4. Appeal Jury decisions are final and may not be appealed.

9. APPEALS

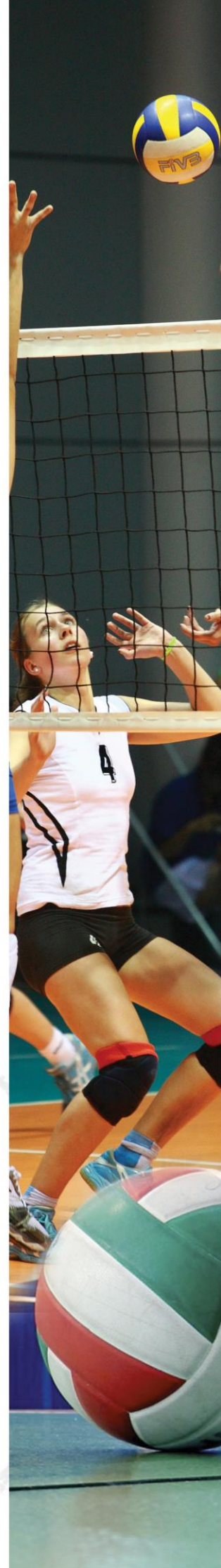
- 9.1. Appeals against results or any other appeal not concerning disciplinary matters will be heard by the Appeal Jury.
- 9.2. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the incident and be in writing in English, French or German.
- 9.3. The sum of 50 EUR must accompany the appeal. This sum will be refunded only if the appeal is upheld or at the discretion of the Appeal Jury.

10. ISF SCHOOL SPORT FOUNDATION

- 10.1. The ISF Executive Committee at its last meeting in Rome, Italy on 28th October 2014 approved the creation of the ISF School Sport Foundation intended to provide underprivileged school children opportunities to access sports training by highly qualified PE teachers and trainers and to dispose of good quality school sport equipment and infrastructure.

Fundraising for the Foundation will be set up at different occasions. For this we call on your solidarity.

One of the occasions is a Charity Gala Dinner that will be organised during the ISF World Schools Championship and will replace the traditional dinner of the Heads of Delegation. Heads of Delegation will be invited to participate in the Charity Gala Dinner and will be asked to pay an extra contribution of 50 € for taking part. The Organising Committee will then pay the collected money in the Foundation's account.



A second way to raise funds for the School Sport Foundation is a free contribution that you can add to the 40 € ISF levy of the participants in the World Schools Championships. You can add 5 €, 10 € or 15 € per participant to the ISF levy to pay. Instead of paying 40 €, you thus pay 45 €, 50 € or 55 € per participant. The Organising Committee will pay the surplus in the ISF School Sport Foundation's account.

In this way everybody will contribute to this good cause. We thank you in advance for your appreciated cooperation.

- 10.2. To help the Organising Committee to process your payment correctly please complete the form 'payment overview' in attachment and send it to the OC by e-mail when you pay the balance. You will also find an example to guide you completing the form.

11. OBLIGATIONS UNDERTAKEN BY DELEGATIONS

- 11.1. Each participant is required to be present throughout the duration of the event.
- 11.2. Each participant is obliged to take part in all of the non-sport activities.
- 11.3. Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- 11.4. Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- 11.5. The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving-, and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the disqualification of that team.

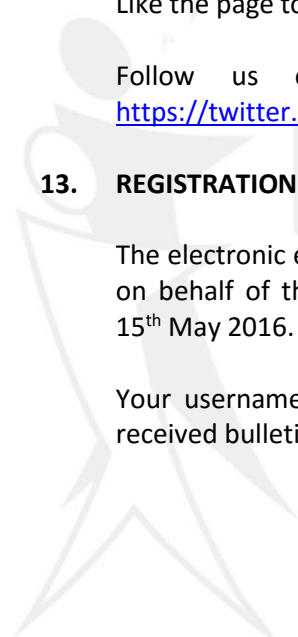
